Behind us lie many memorable and pleasant events. Before us stretches the future—vast, unknown, and yet to be conquered.

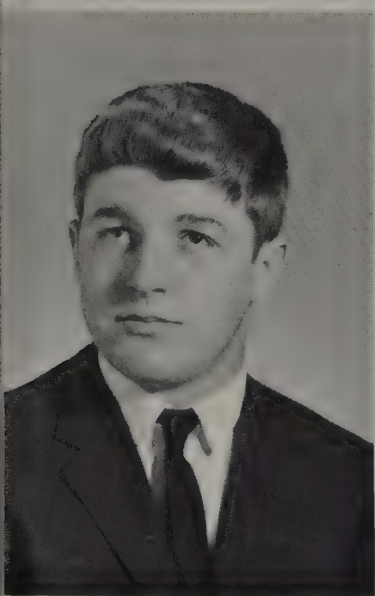
