A Resolution.

Adopted by the Council of Pamplin City, Va. in regular monthly meeting assembled Thursday evening, January seventh, Nineteen hundred and twenty six, in Council room at Pamplin, City, Va.

Vote--Ayes-- Brightwell, Moran, Farrar, Loving, Ligon, Pugh.
Nays-- None.

Be it resolved by the Council of the Town of Pamplin, City, that L. N. Ligon S. P. Loving and N. E. Farrar be and are hereby appointed a committee with full authority to have prepared an amendment to the Charter of the said Town of Pamplin City, making the said Town of Pamplin City, Virginia, a separate Road District.

Further, that the said Town of Pamplin City be by such act, exempted from the levy and collection of any road tax by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Appomattox and Prince Edward, together with such other amendments as the said committee may consider for best interest of the Citizens of the said Town of Pamplin City, Virginia, and respectfully present such proposed amendments to our representatives, Senator S. L. Ferguson and Delegate Claud Wood, for passage earliest possible date in order that Nineteen hundred and twenty six Road Tax may accrue to the Town for maintenance of Streets and roads within said Town.
