We are confident that the vast majority of Virginians do not care for the Design as approved by the Memorial Committee.

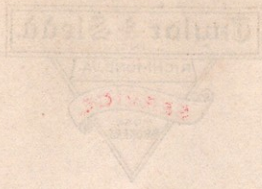
We would be glad to have an expression of opinion from you on this subject.
