My dear Mr Ferguson:-

Taking advantage of the very kind offer made by you to the writer over phone few days since, we are enclosing an exact copy of the old charter of the Town of Pamplin, and also two additional sections as outlined by us to be added.

We are deeply indebted to you for your very kind services in thus taking an outline of what we want and having same prepared in proper form to be presented for passgae in the House and Senate

You will note that a preparation of the amendments will not be very difficult as we consider the old charter confers all the rights and privileges under the State Laws given to small towns and really needs no amendment except as herein mentioned.

There has been some controversy as to jurisdiction of the town over certain streets, and the section coverings intended to set that at rest .

We also want to use the road fund for street purposes and the copy of section 19 of your charter of Appomattox covers that and we have sent copy to you herewith.

We do not think it at all neccessry that you have proposed amendments sent back to me for approval, unless you find the expressed desires above not fully covered in the sectuons we have outlined and your good judgema^t should see fit to change them.

We thank you in advance for both your attention personally and also for your suggestions to Representative Wood, that the Bill may pass promptly and secure for us the desired changes.
