Dear Friend Ferguson:

I did not receive a wire from you last week so assumed that you could not get a private interview with Major Shirley. I held myself in readiness to go if I heard from you, if it were possible.

Now with regard to the public hearing on allocations. That section of Route 10 in which we have special interest between Petersburg and Appomattox, lies half in the Lynchburg District and half in the Richmond District, the Districts meeting in Burkeville, and therefore while the hearing for the Lynchburg District is on the 8th of December in Charlottesville, and the hearing for the Richmond District on the 9th in Petersburg, I believe it will be more convenient to get delegations to go to Petersburg than to Charlottesville. So far as I am personally concerned I will be glad to go to either place, but it seems to me that the majority of the people would rather go to Petersburg and I do believe we ought to have a good delegation there on the 9th.

I hope you will look after a delegation from Appomattox. I have asked W. R. Jones of Blackstone to look after Nottoway, and Senator Kendig to look after Lunenburg. I am also writing to Leslie Ligon at Pamplin, and to Loving.

I still have hopes that we may get a little hard surfacing on Route 10 out of these next allocations, but whether we do or not it is important to make a side-show of interest. My idea is not to go before the Commission in an attitude of kicking and complaint, but simply urging respectfully the Commission's earnest consideration of what we have in mind, so that whether they can do anything more for us now than they have arranged for in their tentative allocations or not it will place us in excellent line for first consideration out of any funds which may come into their hands and not already allocated.


