I enclose copy of a letter I am sending throughout the State with regard to the three constitutional amendments to be voted on this Fall.

The only one of these amendments of real importance is the one permitting the State to change the appropriation year so that we can have the appropriation year the same as the fiscal year.

The other two amendments are not objectionable and the people of Arlington County are very anxious for the passage of the amendment which would only apply to Arlington County at this time.

I would be most appreciative if you could write some letters throughout your District urging the adoption of these amendments. So far as I know there is no objection to them but they should not be confused with the other amendments to be voted on in the Fall of 1928.
